

Troop 80 Social Security Number (SSN) Policy

1. This policy is adopted pursuant to Texas Business and Commerce Code 35.581.
2. Social Security numbers of Scouts and registered adults are collected from the official BSA Application Form, the Eagle Application, or by personal request to the adult, parent or guardian of a Scout.
3. The SSN is used when requested by military bases for security reasons and in BSA forms.
4. The Eagle application will be kept by lock and key in the Advancement office at the Jack Bryant Scout Center (Troop 80 Building) located at 1615 Bellaire St.
5. The SSN numbers are kept on the computer of the Chartered Organization Representative and are printed only as needed to give to military installations.
6. Hard copies of the SSN of the Scout and Adults used for access to military bases are destroyed after the trip on which they are used.
7. This policy is effective August 9, 2005.
