Troop 80 Social Security Number (SSN) Policy

- 1. This policy is adopted pursuant to Texas Business and Commerce Code 35.581.
- 2. Social Security numbers of Scouts and registered adults are collected from the official BSA Application Form, the Eagle Application, or by personal request to the adult, parent or guardian of a Scout.
- 3. The SSN is used when requested by military bases for security reasons and in BSA forms.
- 4. The Eagle application will be kept by lock and key in the Advancement office at the Jack Bryant Scout Center (Troop 80 Building) located at 1615 Bellaire St.
- 5. The SSN numbers are kept on the computer of the Chartered Organization Representative and are printed only as needed to give to military installations.
- 6. Hard copies of the SSN of the Scout and Adults used for access to military bases are destroyed after the trip on which they are used.
- 7. This policy is effective August 9, 2005.
