Cost: By Patrols

Location: Campsite is located west of Fritch Highway (Hwy 136) and south of McBride Canyon near where Coetas Creek meets the Canadian river.

Bring: Sack lunch and drink to backpack for lunch on Saturday, backpacking equipment, compass, eating utensils/plate/cup, backpacking stoves and fuel. Be prepared for any kind of weather (cold, snow, or rain)

Camp Notes: Treated water will not be brought into camp. It is plentiful; however, it will need to be treated with chemicals or by boiling. Be prepared to cook over camp stoves since there may be a fire ban in place. Patrol menus will be set by the patrol leader with the squad leader approval.
